42nd WARD ALDERMAN BRENDAN REILLY ENDORSES SCHROEDER FOR STATE REPRESENTATIVE

“The State faces tough choices, and David Schroeder is the best candidate”

Chicago, IL – Brendan Reilly, alderman of the 42nd Ward in the City of Chicago, endorsed David Schroeder for state representative in the Democratic primary to be held on February 2, 2010.

“The State of Illinois faces tough choices, and we need someone in the General Assembly who can provide leadership and represent the people who live in the heart of Chicago,” said Reilly. “David Schroeder is the best candidate for State Representative from the 5th District.”
